2023 Breeding regulations

Before your mare arrives to be covered, a copy of the passport, vaccinations and test results must be emailed to this address: haras-cercy@orange.fr

Foreign mares must be registered and possess a SIRE number *

**This is the process of registration in the French system, which we will carry out upon the mare's arrival*

VACCINATION (Equine Influenza and Rhinopneumonitis):

- Breeding protocol to be applied:
Primary injection 21-60 days > First booster 120 – 180 days > 6-monthly boosters
- Before covering, the mare must have received a minimum of the first two injections (minimum 21 days and maximum 60 days).

Upon arrival of your mare in France, we will carry out the necessary tests for Equine Viral Arteritis (EVA) and Contagious Equine Metritis (CEM).


EQUINE VIRAL ARTERITIS (EVA):

- Sample to be taken after 1st January 2023
- Negative result to serological or ELISA test
- In the event of a positive result:
 - Either two positive serological results, stable or decreasing, at an interval of at least 14 days. Tests must be undertaken in the same laboratory.
 - Or one positive serological result, stable or decreasing compared to a test taken within the last year.

DOURINE TEST (FOR MARES ARRIVING FROM ITALY)

Two negative blood tests to be taken no more than 28 days prior to arrival to France, the second one to be taken at least 14 days after the arrival at the boarding stud.

Mares on foaling-heat are not prioritized.

In the event of unsuccessful coverings from two heat cycles, a cervical bacteria test (all germs) may be required prior to a further attempt. Any mare in an unsatisfactory sanitary condition or displaying signs of ill-health, cervical discharge or dangerous behaviour, may be refused at the discretion of the Haras de Cercy.
